THE TUITION BENEFIT AWARD PROGRAM - PROVIDING EXCELLENCE FOR THE FUTURE:

Providing excellence in health care depends upon the availability of qualified employees. The Health Alliance of Greater Cincinnati is committed to providing opportunities for individuals to enter very challenging and rewarding health care careers. Our Health Careers Tuition Benefit Award Program demonstrates this commitment.

TUITION BENEFIT AWARD OFFERS:

The Tuition Benefit Award Program will provide financial assistance to selected students enrolled in and accepted in Health Care Career Programs, who are in the final year of the program.

1. A tuition benefit award of \$6,000 for tuition, fees, and textbooks will be awarded to the student. The student will, in turn, provide the Health Alliance with a 18-month full-time (32 hours or more per week) employment commitment after graduation working as a licensed Physical Therapist/Occupational Therapist (PT/OT).
2. The student must begin working for the Health Alliance as a Physical Therapist/Occupational Therapist (PT/OT) within 6 months of the graduation date.

REQUIREMENTS:

Minimum requirements necessary to receive consideration for the tuition benefit award program:

- Current enrollment and acceptance as a student in an eligible Health Care Career Program with an accredited college. Student is in the final year of the program.
- A letter of recommendation from a clinical instructor or faculty who can comment not only on your academic standing, but also your work ethic and personal achievements.
- An official copy of your current college transcript from an accredited college indicating a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Work commitment for full-time (32 hours or more per week) employment with a Health Alliance hospital upon completion of the course requirements for college graduation. The work commitment starts once the student is licensed as a Physical Therapist/Occupational Therapist (PT/OT) and is working at a Health Alliance location.

SUBMIT THE TUITION BENEFIT AWARD APPLICATION:

To be eligible, students must complete the entire application (all pages), attach a letter of recommendation, and provide an official copy of your college transcript from an accredited college. Applicant must sign and submit all documents to *The Health Alliance, Attn: Tuition Benefit Award Coordinator, Corporate Recruitment, 3200 Burnet Ave., A-Level South, Cincinnati, OH 45229*, at the time of application to be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Health Alliance Human Resources Department reviews applications and makes all final selections for Tuition Benefit Awards. You will be notified of approval or denial approximately one month following the Health Alliance's receipt of your application.
